# Da Nang at a glance...

**Da Nang** is one of the most popular tourist destinations of Vietnam. This is one of the twenty cleanest cities in the world and the most livable city in Vietnam.

Visitors now can visit the famous picturesque spots such as Ba Na Hills, Son Tra Peninsula, My Khe Beach...

From Da Nang, visitors can travel to three World heritages: Hoi An ancient town in distance of 30km, My Son ruins in 45km, as well as Hue ancient capital in 100km conveniently.



### Three World heritages

- **Hue** is a city in central Vietnam that was the capital of Đàng Trong Kingdom from 1738 to 1775 and of the Nguyen Dynasty from 1802 to 1945.
- **Hoi An** is recognized as an exceptionally well-preserved example of a Southeast Asian trading port dating from the 15<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> century.
- **My Son** is a cluster of abandoned and partially ruined Hindu temples in Quang Nam province, central Vietnam, constructed between the 4th and the 14th century.

   Each group includes 03 lecturers as advisors, plus 02 volunteers from Host university.
